Failure to comply will lead to corrective action measures up to and including termination of the business relationship.

Basic Human Rights

ICC is dedicated to upholding and promoting human rights as outlined in the International Bill of Human Rights, which includes the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the international Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, and the International Covenant on Economic, Social, and Cultural Rights. We believe that respect for human dignity is fundamental to our values and operations. All partners must abide by these basic human rights.

Employment and Worker's Rights

ICC is dedicated to conducting our business in a manner that ensures the fair and ethical treatment of all individuals, including employees, customers, suppliers, contractors and communities in which we operate. We do not tolerate any form of forced labor, child labor, human trafficking, or other human rights abuses within our business or supply chain. We are committed to the principles of the International Labour Organization (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work. Business partners must abide by the same principles. All work must be voluntary and performed by those over the age of 16.

Our commitment extends to fostering a safe, inclusive, and respectful workplace where all employees have the right to fair wages, freedom of association, and a workplace free from harassment and exploitation. ICC does not discriminate based on race, religion, age, disability, family or marital status, gender identity or expression, political affiliation, sexual orientation nor color. We require our partners and suppliers to adhere to similar principles, ensuring that human rights are upheld across our global operations. If you have concerns regarding potential human rights violations related to our business, we encourage you to report them through our established grievance mechanisms, ensuring transparency and accountability in our commitment to human rights.
